Currently, the FCZD is working on:

- ✓ Flood Hazard Comprehensive Management Plan
- ✓ Countywide levee inventory
- ✓ Flood hazard response plan
- ✓ Application into FEMA's Community Rating System
- ✓ Public education and outreach
- ✓ Working with Congress to fund a weather radar feasible study
- ✓ Continue to assist with post-fire recovery efforts

Flood Hazard Comprehensive Plan Update

- ✓ Approximately 70% complete, including draft Action Plan/Capital Improvements
- ✓ Stakeholders meetings 4th Wednesday of every month at CTC, 1:00 – 3:00 (double check the FCZD webpage to ensure a meeting is being held for the month). Public welcome to attend and provide comments.
- ✓ Past stakeholders meeting notes/summaries located on the county's FCZD webpage.
- ✓ Stakeholders consist of representatives from all cities, three members of the public, USFS, Cascadia Conservation District, PUD, WSDOT, Ecology, National Weather Service, Reclamation District, CD Land Trust, and other county departments.
- ✓ Three Open Houses were held last week to detail specific damage and economic loss estimates from different flooding events for residential, commercial, industrial buildings and identified critical facilities by typing in an address.
- ✓ UPCOMING: Once Comprehensive Plan is complete another Open House will be held and comments accepted.
