Learn how to reduce the risk of wildfire damage to your property and home by maintaining healthy forests.

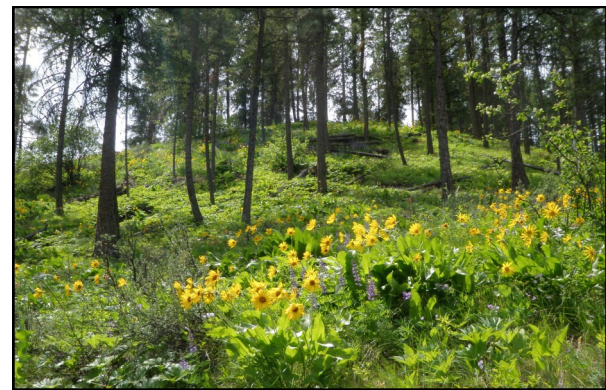
Before Treatment:
