PROTECT YOUR DRINKING WATER

- Use toilets when available and locate them before needed.
- Pack out all human waste or dig a hole 6-8 inches deep and 200 feet away from water or campsite, fill hole and cover with soil.
- Wash dishes and bathe at least 200 feet away from all water, and don't use any type of soap.
- Avoid fragile vegetation, stay on designated trails. Keep pets and stock animals at least 200 feet from lakes and streams.
